Includes a reconstructed Anglo-Saxon Village built on the site of an original settlement; finds from the site displayed in a specially built interpretation centre; 125 acre Country Park, with children's play area, nature trail, bird hides, café and gift shop.

**Location:** 6 miles north-west of Bury St Edmunds, just off the A1101. Follow brown signs to the Anglo-Saxon Village.

**Admission:** The Anglo-Saxon Village is open daily from 10am to 5pm (last entry at 4pm in Summer, 3.30pm in Winter). Normal admission to the Anglo-Saxon Village: Adult £5, Child £4, Family £15. Admission on Special event days: Adult £6, Child £5, Family £17.50. Parking & admission to the Country Park is FREE.
